# **Policy for sustainability**

Moelven respects people and the environment. Our business is based on renewable resources, and we have made sustainability and long-term commitment our competitive advantage, and have a strong determination to take responsibility for our environment.

To Moelven, sustainability is about making choices that contribute to create long-term value for the company, while also making the right choices out of consideration to the outside world. Sustainability is thus a natural part of the company strategy, through its vision, values and policies.

Moelven takes responsibility for the environment through sustainable and long-term utilisation of renewable resources. Our goal is continuous environmental improvement in our projects, products and services. We actively seek opportunities to reduce negative environmental impacts in a life cycle perspective. Moelven shall conduct its business in compliance with applicable statutes, regulations and rules. Moelven works towards a sustainable development of society and to constantly improve the business's impact on the internal and external environment.

Moelven has defined four focus areas and one basic premise for sustainability, where the basic premise is based on the code of conduct that applies to the entire group. The four key focus areas are linked to four of the UN sustainability goals. The focus areas in combination with the UN's sustainability goals, the basic premise for sustainability at Moelven and the code of conduct, all form the basis for identifying the most important aspects for the outside world and for long-term value creation in the Group. This comprises the foundation for sustainability at Moelven.

## Moelven's policy:

• Moelven shall actively work to reduce its climate and environmental footprint.

- The environmental impact of transport shall be minimised through coordination and optimisation of the product flow. The environment shall be considered in the choice of transport method and the group's current objectives for environmental standards shall be taken into account when choosing partners.
- Moelven shall have a good understanding of its role in the carbon cycle and demonstrate that Moelven is climate positive.
- Moelven shall actively participate in technology and market developments in the bioenergy sector, and investigate alternative energy sources at those plants who use fossil fuel for heating.
- Moelven's products shall have environmental assessments and certifications that meet the customers' and market's needs.

# Moelven's policy:

- Moelven shall utilise the entire timber log, including all by-products
- Moelven shall optimise raw material utilisation to improve resource efficiency and to maximise the value of the raw material
- All timber Moelven buys must as a minimum comply with FSC® Controlled Wood or PEFC™
  Controlled Sources. Purchase of certified timber must as a minimum be adapted to needs
  based on the group's sales of certified finished products.
- Purchased raw materials must not originate from:

- Illegal harvests.
- Forests with a high preservation value.
- Forests where time-honoured or social rights are violated.
- Forests with genetically manipulated trees.
- Natural forest that has been cut for the purpose of using the area for crops.
- Moelven shall design products that focus on resource efficiency, and assess the need for and environmental impact of packaging.
- Moelven shall actively work to reduce waste and have a minimum sorting rate of 90% for residual waste.
- Moelven shall actively work to minimise the use of plastic, and work to find alternative and sustainable materials to plastic.
